1. Personalized Photo Coasters

Materials needed:

- 4x4 inch ceramic tiles
- Printed photos (sized to fit the tiles)
- Mod Podge
- Foam brush
- Felt pads
- Clear acrylic sealer spray

- 1. Clean the ceramic tiles with rubbing alcohol and let them dry completely.
- 2. Cut your photos to fit the tiles exactly.

- 8. Once fully dry, add felt pads to the bottom of each tile to protect surfaces.
